until they  
hatch.



Curlew chicks can run  
about at 2 days old but  
can't fly until they  
are 6 weeks  
old.



Curlews  
make a grassy  
nest on the ground  
and lay 3 or 4  
camouflaged eggs.



Adult  
curlews  
return to the  
uplands in Spring.  
They communicate with  
each other using a  
'Cur-lee' call.
